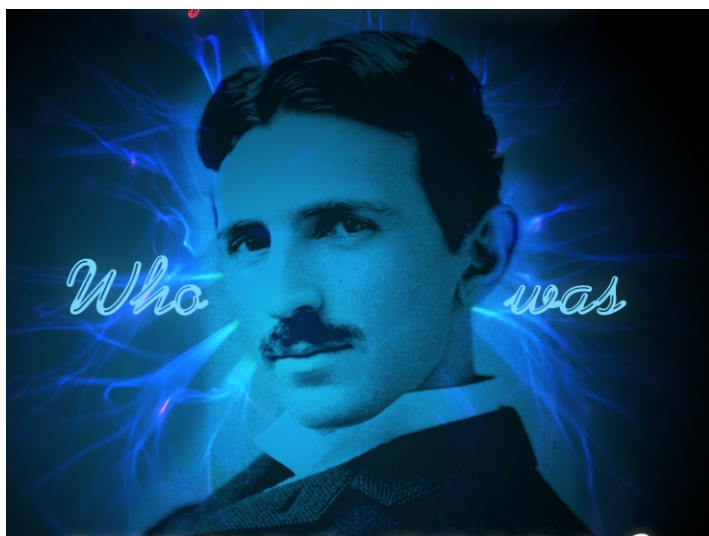
Provide support for new book about Tesla
